INTRODUCTION

When we talk about on-pack logos, it is important to identify the distinction between disposal logos and identification codes.

Disposal guide

Over the past decades EU countries have developed their own logos to make it clear to consumers how best to dispose of packaging. The logos designed for this purpose differ from country to country, as the ways in which each country collects and sorts waste are also different. The overview in this document (note: not yet complete) shows for each member state which logo or combination of logos can - or cannot - be used. The overview is based on publicly available information and will be updated when needed.

Identification codes

Identification codes serve to facilitate the collection, reuse and recovery (including recycling) of packaging materials. Numbers in a triangle indicate the type of material, and even more specifically for instance the type of plastic. These identification codes can be found <u>here</u>. The use of these codes is not obligatory in Europe (if material identification codes are used one must adhere to the prescribed numbering).

- 1. Packaging recycling <u>mark</u> with <u>digit</u> in the middle
- 2. Seperate collection mark
- 3. Trade mark of the recovery organisation

Note: a specific set of pictograms for the separate collection (2) has not been developed. Use of 'tidyman' sign or text can be used.
